What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored by your web browser when you use websites. Cookies may be first-party cookies (sent by **BERA**) or third-party (sent by other companies). Cookies help personalize your web browsing experience by storing information about your visit—such as your preferred language—so that you do not have to enter this information each time you visit a website. Some cookies ensure that the graphics on a website appear correctly, while others make sure a website application works properly.

Cookies may be required for our website to work, provide information on our website's functionality and performance for maintenance and improvement, or provide information about your browsing habits such as your history or how long you stay on a page.

How Do We Use Cookies?

Strictly Necessary Cookies: These cookies are essential to enable you to access and navigate our website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website. Without these cookies, services you request—such as shopping baskets or electronic billing—cannot be provided.

We only use strictly necessary cookies on **bera.global**. We use these cookies to help us provide you services such as user authentication, access to secure areas of our website, shopping cart, etc.

Managing Your Cookies

On Our Website

We only use strictly necessary cookies on **bera.global**. We have designed our website to properly function using cookies. If you disable cookies, our website may not function properly, or your experience may be substantially impacted, preventing you from fully experiencing our website and its content.

In Your Browser
